

Rector's Letter

Friends,

This spring we are doing two things that we haven't done here at Grace Church in 25 years: We are undertaking a capital campaign, and we are calling a new Director of Music. Both of these worthy projects have involved many hours of work over a period of many months. Both have engaged committees of parishioners to spearhead these efforts. Both have been hard work, but both have also been fruitful...and fun!

As is generally the case with worthy endeavors in this life, they take time to bear fruit. It will be a couple years, for instance, before we see the completion of the building that the capital campaign is helping to fund. It will also take time for our new Director of Music to expand our music program here at Grace. But, in both cases, growth is already present. Scaffolding is already up around our church, and actual repair work is imminent. And our next Director of Music will by no means be starting from scratch, thanks to those who are singing in the choir and the wonderful leadership of our interim Organist/Choir Director, Christian Lane.

In all the meetings of these committees, we have prayed for God's guidance and blessing. I ask for your prayers for both of these parish initiatives. In this past Sunday's Gospel reading, we heard Jesus speak to the need to always ground our lives (both individually and communally) in him: "Just as the branch cannot bear fruit by itself unless it abides in the vine, neither can you unless you abide in me." (John 15:4) As these two "once-in-a-quarter-century" endeavors take form, let us rejoice in what God is doing here at Grace...and continue to pray for God's guidance and blessing for all that we do here in the heart of downtown Providence.
