

Spotlight on Grace: Give Yourself the Gift of the Sacred 3 Days

Lent is drawing to a close, and this Sunday we enter into Holy Week. Holy Week forms the core of our Christian faith: Palm Sunday and the Triduum - the three days from the evening of Maundy

Thursday through Good Friday and Holy Saturday - and on to Easter. Our celebration of the Resurrection finds its most full expression when together we walk with our Lord through the events of Holy Week.

During these days we (with Christians around the world) relive, re-enact, remember, and experience Jesus's last days on earth. It was his death, resurrection, and ascension - the



message of God's victory of life over death and the hope of new life for all believers - that Jesus's earliest followers proclaimed to others.
