Through our Outreach ministry, we have been working on potential outreach initiatives

here on-site at Grace and have been in conversation with Grace Apartments about hosting a meal for their residents on a regular basis, beginning later this coming year. So while our AA hosting ministry comes to a close, we look forward to new ministries of hospitality here at Grace Church to come very soon!
