

Spotlight on Grace: An Invitation to the Triduum

For those of you who, like myself, grew up in families and churches where you went to church on Palm Sunday and then didn't set foot in church again until Easter Sunday, the services of Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil (collectively called "The Triduum" by the Church), can be profoundly new and moving.

I still remember my first Maundy Thursday service at St. Stephen's Church up on College Hill when I was 19. It brought me into the final, full day of Christ's life like nothing else I had ever known.

Speaking of College Hill, we will continue the Grace Church tradition of having a guest preacher for our Good Friday

service by welcoming into our pulpit this year the Chaplain of Brown University, the Rev. Janet Cooper Nelson (bio below).



The next day, the Easter Vigil at 8:00 on Saturday evening begins with hopeful waiting in near darkness and moves into the celebration of the Resurrection of Christ, full of light, music, and joy. The Vigil is a unique worship experience in the church year, and I hope many of you will be moved to attend, some of you for the first time!

I look forward to traveling these three days in the life of Christ and the Church with you all here at Grace.

Please Welcome Good Friday Guest Preacher The Rev. Janet Cooper Nelson



Ordained in 1980 by the United Church of Christ, Rev. Please join us on Thursdays at Noon through May 25 for in for mal half-hour organ, voca l or instrumental concerts.


