

Spotlight on Grace: A Palm Sunday Message from the Rector

Back in 1999, when I was an aspiring comedy writer, I signed with a talent agency, all of whose writers were on the staffs of TV shows. I was thrilled. Truth be told, it was one of the best days of my life. Then, almost immediately, "Who Wants to be a Millionaire?" came on the air and was soon on five nights a week. At the same time, "Survivor" launched its American show, kicking off the reality TV craze.




Scripted comedies went into decline, and, for the first time ever, my agency had writers who weren't being staffed on TV shows. I, and many others, made a living (just) through free-lance jobs, where we could find them. If I had known what the next year or two would hold for me, professionally, would I have been as elated as I was on that day in '99 to be signed by the Endeavor Agency? Probably not. Yet my joy that day was real, and when I remember it now, it still brings a smile to my face, even though I never was on the writing staff of a TV show.

If the crowds that greeted Jesus with such joy on that first "Palm Sunday" had known that, in a matter of days, the prophet they greeted with cheers would be arrested and executed, would they have been so joyful? Probably not, either. But two things are true of the experience of that final week of Jesus's life and those who followed him: The joy of that day on which Jesus entered Jerusalem astride a donkey was real, and, in a sense, permanent. And secondly, the pain that followed was not the final chapter. Easter Sunday followed Good Friday. It still does.

When we lift up our palms in church on Sunday in memory of that glorious day in the life of Christ, perhaps we can also remember that our joys - even when they are followed later by loss - are as real as real can be and can, if we let them, sustain us through our Good Fridays, until we reach our own Easters.



The annual performance of the Holy Week Passion music on Good Friday was one of the

musical highlights of the Leipzig church year, for on this day, concerted music was only presented in one of the four churches for which Bach was responsible. The Matthew Passion for three choirs and two orchestras is Bach's most dramatic and complex score - startling and arresting choruses contrasting with sublime solo arias. Tickets range from \$20 - \$50, and will be available at the door. There is a show at PPAC scheduled as well, so we recommend allowing time for and giving forethought to parking.

The Lenten Giving Cross


Our Lenten Giving Cross supply drive to benefit foster families through Children's Friend is
