Spotlight on Grace: Works by Edna Lawrence on Display



When you come in for worship this Sunday, please be sure to visit the reception area of The Pavilion to enjoy the nine original pen and ink drawings by Edna Lawrence that we've just installed along this curved wall.

Edna Lawrence (1898-1987) taught at RISD for more than 50 years (1922-1974), and founded the school's Nature Lab <u>which</u> <u>now bears her name</u>. Both locally and through her extensive travels, she

ammassed a natural history collection of more than 25,000 specimens that continue to inspire students today. Edna Lawrence's renderings of motifs from the interior and exterior of Grace Church were created for the purpose of embellishing our sunday bulletins and other communications, and they likewise remain in frequent use today.

All of us here at Grace Church would like to express our profound gratitude to <u>artist and RISD professor</u> <u>Andrew Raftery</u>, not only for his faithful stewardship of Grace Church's archive of Edna Lawrence drawings and printing blocks over many years, but also for his generous gift of time and effort in selecting the pieces for this permanent exhibit and for framing them so beautifully. 
Weekly Worship Schedule:

Parking for Worship: Free parking for Sunday worship is provided:


1.) in the lot diagonally across Westminster Street, on the NW corner of Westminster and Snow;

2.) On the **top level only** of the PPAC parking garage, for which the entrance is on Weybosset Street. A stairway from the top level leads right to Chapel Street across from the church; and

3.) In the Grace Church parking lot accessed via Snow Street. We ask your kind cooperation in reserving this lot, to the extent possible, for seniors and those with limited mobility.




Sunday School Resumes January 21
