Hidden beneath the old wall-to-wall carpets, we found the hardwood floors just waiting to shine anew with a fresh sand-and-finish. Then with some plaster repairs and paint, the stage was set for Vince and Liz to truly work their magic. They made resourceful use of items already here, supplemented by thoughtful and frugal purchases to create a pair of spaces that all of us here at Grace can feel proud of. With chairs reupholstered by Vince himself, the table that now anchors the Chafee room was an inexpensive treasure found on Craigslist.

Throughout the process of design and execution, Vince and Liz shared a common vision, and both encountered an uncanny ease of always finding just what they were looking for. Standing back to take in the sight of the completed rooms, Liz remarked:



Grace Church has a decades-long tradition of having a guest preacher at our Good Friday service, and this year we will welcome to our pulpit, for what we believe is the first time, an Orthodox priest - the Very Rev. Elie Estephan. Fr. Elie is the pastor of St. Mary Anthiochian Orthodox Church in Pawtucket. St. Mary Church was founded a century ago by Orthodox Christians from the Middle East, especially Lebanon and Syria. Fr. Elie is himself a native of Lebanon and has served churches in Lebanon and Brazil before





The new wheelchair ramp connects directly from the lot, and you will enter through the new reception entrance of The Pavilion and into the church at ground level.

Parking for Worship: Free parking for Sunday worship is provided:

1.) in the lot diagonally across Westminster Street, on the NW corner of Westminster and Snow;



- 2.) On the **top level only** of the PPAC parking garage, for which the entrance is on Weybosset Street. A stairway from the top level leads right to Chapel Street across from the church; and
- 3.) In the Grace Church parking lot accessed via Snow Street. We ask your kind cooperation in reserving this lot, to the extent possible, for seniors and those with limited mobility.
