From the raw American sound of Billings' *I am the Rose of Sharon* to the elegant playfulness of the Bach *Wedding Cantata*, this concert is a veritable roller-coaster

of musical emotion. The centerpiece of the concert is Chritopher DeBlasio's *The Best Beloved*, a four-movement set of pieces for choir and strings.

The poetry ranges from the Psalms to John Donne and the text-painting takes us from battered to blissful. 

Prayer Group: The prayer group meets the 2nd and 4th Saturday of each month at 9:30am, presently in The Pavilion at Grace.

Wheelchair Access and Accessible Parking: Please find convenient accessible in the Grace Church parking lot with access from Snow Street. The new wheelchair ramp connects directly from the lot, and



you will enter through the new reception entrance of The Pavilion and into the church at ground level.

Parking for Worship: Free parking for Sunday worship is provided:

- 1.) in the lot diagonally across Westminster Street, on the NW corner of Westminster and Snow;
- 2.) On the **top level only** of the PPAC parking garage, for which the entrance is on Weybosset Street. A stairway from the top level leads right to Chapel Street across from the church; and
- 3.) In the Grace Church parking lot accessed via Snow Street. We ask your kind cooperation in reserving this lot, to the extent possible, for seniors and those with limited mobility.
