

Spotlight on Grace: A Feast for the Eyes

Often when we talk of feasts we're referring to holy days or feasts in the church calendar, and indeed this midweek we had occasion to recall and celebrate The Conversion of Saint Paul the Apostle. But the feast I'd like to share with you today is of a different sort entirely: it is a feast for the eyes.

By the grace of God, our church received a great blessing this past week in the form of a stunning new series of photographs gifted by hobbyist photographer Brian Kutner. Brian strolled into Grace during our Open Doors hours while in Providence recently, and resolved to drive back up from New Jersey solely to record the beauty of Grace Church. Brian has honed specialized techniques for photographing church interiors, including by taking multiple exposures of a

single composition and combining them to balance out the extremes of light and dark.



Prayer shawls are created with prayer and given out to those who are going through difficult times in body, mind or spirit.






