Celebration of Life: Our community will gather this Saturday morning, April 30, for a celebration of the life of longtime parishioner Mary E. Thorpe, who passed away earlier this month. All are invited to attend. May Mary's soul, and the souls of all the departed, rest in peace. The doors will open at 9:00am; service begins at 10:00am.

Celebration of Faith: This Sunday, May 1, Bishop Nicholas Knisely

will make his annual visitation to Grace Church. He will preach and celebrate the eucharist at both



the 8:00am and 10:00am services, with the 10:00am service featuring additional cause for celebration as several Grace parishioners will be confirmed or received by the bishop. 
