This is an exciting time for Music at Grace Church!

This past Friday, August 5, a 145-voice choir from the Royal School of Church Music Newport course filled the chancel at Grace and sang a glorious service of Choral Evensong. Please click here for a wonderful video excerpt, or find it posted on the Grace Church Facebook page.

The appreciative congregation -- which included parents and friends of the choir, Grace parishioners, and folks who wandered in after seeing the sidewalk sign out front -- numbered

about 130!

Director of Music Vince Edwards remarked: "As you can see....it was warm so we decided to forego vestments! The 145-voice choir sang beautifully under the direction of Walden Moore and was masterfully accompanied by Jason Roberts and Patrick A. Scott. Congregation of about 130.....but they couldn't outnumber that choir!!!" What is equally exciting is that almost 100 of those singers were under the age of 18!

This coming Monday, we will take 9 brand new choristers to Incarnation Center in Ivoryton, CT for a 4 day choir camp, officially launching the Grace Church Choristers!

We will be rehearsing, and learning, and playing every day. A typical day might include learning a scale, singing a hymn, learning a setting of the *Nunc Dimittis*, learning about a portion of the liturgical year or Eucharistic liturgy, playing Monopoly, playing Bingo, swimming in the lake, tie-dyeing a shirt, playing kick ball and sharing great meals. On Sunday, September 11, we will welcome these new choristers into the Choir of Grace

Church and rejoice in being part of a centuries-old tradition of young people singing the world's greatest sacred music in a great sacred space.

A temporary wheelchair ramp is now complete,


providing wheelchair access from the sidewalk on Westminster Street into the church. Handicapped parking spaces have been posted for Sundays on Mathewson Street near Westminster.

YOU can help send a vulnerable child to school ready to learn!


Please Support the Grace Church Outreach Ministry's Back to School Supply Drive for Children's Friend.


