Happy Thanksgiving!

If you visited a Nordstroms in the last week or two, you may have seen a sign in the window saying, "We won't be decking our halls until Friday, November 27. Why? Well, we just like the idea of celebrating one holiday at a time." For the Church, we tend to wait even a bit longer for Christmas (though I commend Nordstrom on their patience), calling this period of expectation "Advent," which is Latin for "coming." In other words, we are expectantly waiting the annual celebration of the coming of the messiah.

This Advent, we're inviting everyone to participate in a program called AdventWord which is the Anglican Communion's Global Advent Calendar. By signing up at adventword.org, you'll receive daily, two-minute video meditations from the Society of Saint John the Evangelist, an Episcopal order of monks just an hour north of us in Cambridge. For those of you who are up on social media, you'll also have the opportunity through AdventWord to share with other Anglicans across the globe (and with other parishioners on Grace's own Facebook page).



I hope you all will be moved this month to take part in this Advent discipline, as well as the many activities at Grace listed below.
