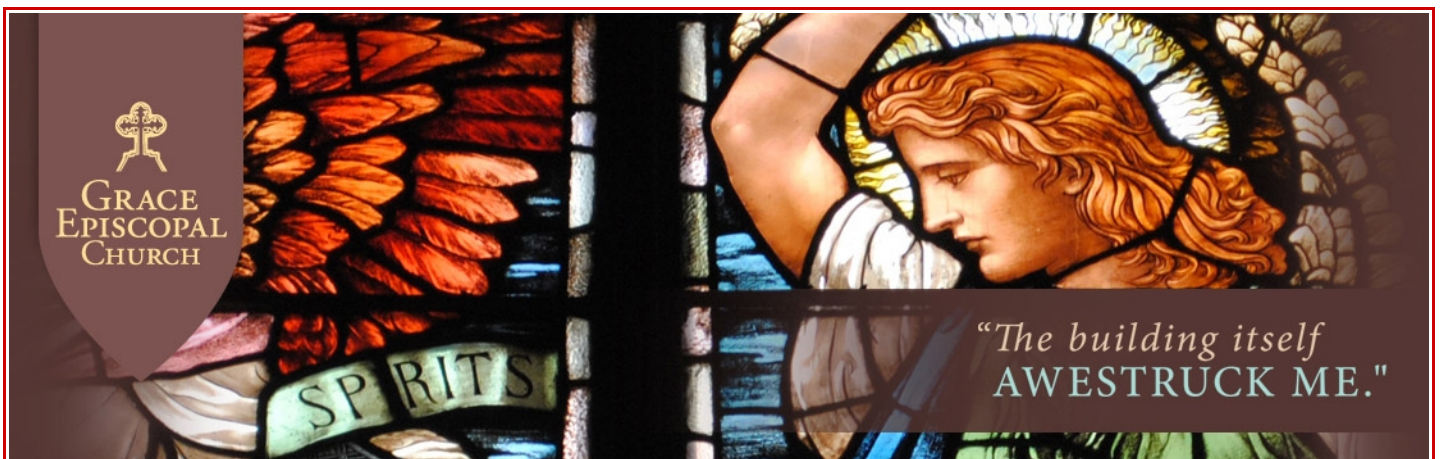
Dear Friends,
