We here at Grace are thrilled to unveil the newly renovated spaces on the second and third floors on the west side of the campus, and this Sunday we will rejoice as our Sunday School and Nursery begin to make use of these beautiful spaces.

Over the past few months, we've repaired and painted walls, refinished or replaced floors, installed new lights, rebuilt and remodeled bathrooms, and appointed these spaces with furniture and finishing touches.

Your Director of Music Vince Edwards and buildings & grounds chair Liz Wheeler were instrumental in bringing forth a vision for these rooms, and now we can look forward to many years of enjoying their use.

To fully appreciate this blessing, it might be helpful to think back to the pre-restoration condition of these rooms. For example, the photo at right shows the same room that's shown finished above. The second floor rooms, which prior to the restoration had served as the choir vesting and rehearsal spaces, will now be the nursery and the primary Sunday School room (where all Sunday School participants will gather after processing from church).





2017 was of course a hugely transformative year for our beloved campus with the opening of The Pavilion at Grace and Cronhimer Hall, and as we begin 2018 we are so pleased by the further blessing of these newly renovated rooms.


that anyone who is interested will be able to attend one of these meetings.



- 1.) in the lot diagonally across Westminster Street, on the NW corner of Westminster and Snow:
- 2.) On the top level only of the PPAC parking garage, for which the entrance is on

Weybosset Street. A stairway from the top level leads right to Chapel Street across from the church; and


3.) In the Grace Church parking lot accessed via Snow Street. We ask your kind cooperation in reserving this lot, to the extent possible, for seniors and those with limited mobility.


