



With an official kickoff scheduled for Sunday, October 21, the theme for the 2019 Stewardship Campaign for Grace Church will be *Transforming Generosity*. The theme is very apropos, not only as we reflect upon the transformational power of giving according to God's calling in our lives, but also as we unveil two exciting new ways to give.

Mirroring the broader trend in our society, the proportion of Grace Church parishioners who make recurring pledge payments [through our online giving page](#) continues to rapidly grow. We welcome your donations by any method, but electronic giving is faster, more secure, provides important donation consistency, and strengthens our stewardship program overall.

Giving by Mobile App or by Text

We are excited to share with you these two great new ways to give to Grace! GivePlus is a mobile giving app that enables you to make one-time or recurring gifts from your smartphone. Visit the App Store or Google Play and search for "GivePlus" to download the app for free and start donating today! If you already give online, use the same e-mail address, and the system will (we're told) connect to your existing profile. Search for "Grace Church Providence" in the app, choose which fund you'd like to support (Pledge, Music at Grace, etc), and you're on your way. When making donations either [online](#) or through the app, remember that donating straight from a checking or savings account means lower processing fees for the church, so that even more of your kind donation will go straight to supporting our mission and ministry. Those of you accustomed to texting may also enjoy the convenience of giving through Give+ Text. Make one-time or recurring offerings by simply sending a text to our secure account at **401-298-9775**. Simply text the dollar amount of your desired donation, and follow the prompts for the rest. And after your first text donation, future donations are easier still. Please watch the brief tutorial below.




Give+ Text

Unlike the online and mobile app options, donations by text are made only by credit or debit card, which means somewhat higher processing fees incurred by Grace, but for that impromptu donation to the music program while attending a concert, for example, Give+ Text offers the fastest way to give. To direct a text donation to the music program, simply text the dollar amount, a space, and then the word 'music'.

Blessing of the Animals This Sunday

The Reverend Canon Jonathan Huyck will bless the animals at the church at the 10:00am service. Grace Church welcomes everyone and their pets: dogs, cats, rabbits, birds, fish, turtles, and toy pets that are brought to the church for the service and the blessing. The only requirement is that all animals must be properly restrained, leashed or caged.


Parking for Worship: Free parking for Sunday worship is provided:

- 1.) in the lot diagonally across Westminster Street, on the NW corner of Westminster and Snow;
- 2.) On the **top level only** of the PPAC parking garage, for which the entrance is on Weybosset Street. A stairway from the top level leads right to Chapel Street across from the church; and
- 3.) In the Grace Church parking lot accessed via Snow Street. We ask your kind cooperation in reserving this lot, to the extent possible, for seniors and those with limited mobility.
