## Spotlight on Grace: Awaiting The Pavilion's Slab and Steel



Welcome to the ground floor of The Pavilion at Grace! After skilled masons made quick work of the foundation wall this week, the crew then carried fill material into the void to surround the underground plumbing and rise up to near floor-level. That fill was then carefully compacted in preparation for the imminent pouring of the cement slab that will underlay the final floor.

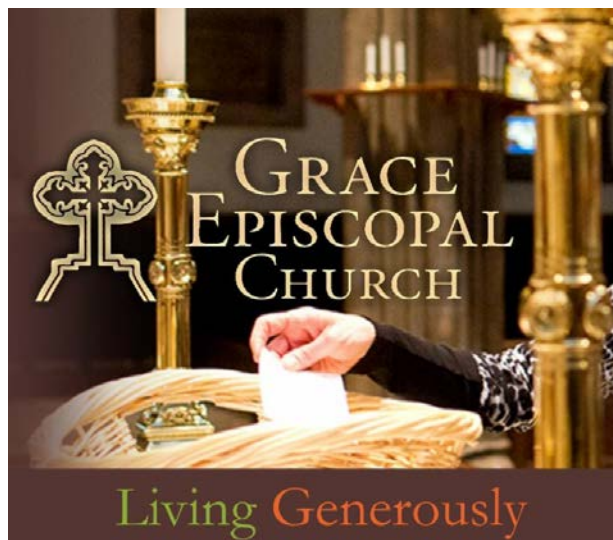
The next piece to watch for in terms of vertical progress will be the erection of the steel structure for the new stair tower, followed shortly thereafter by the arrival of the remaining structural steel on-site. December will be an exciting month of progress as the structure really begins to rise up and take shape right before our eyes.



In the words of PICA's Ron Watts, "Grace Church has really opened its

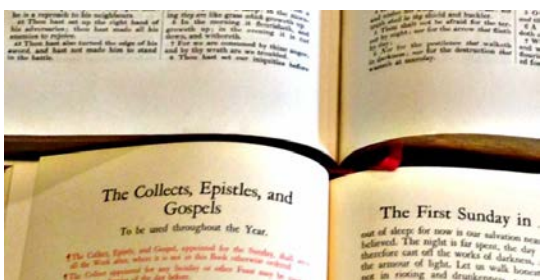


hearts for this year's drive, at a time when the need has never been greater". Please continue to bring your food donations to Grace Church throughout this holiday season and, indeed, throughout the year.
