This concert features 22 talented singers from Rhode Island and Eastern Connecticut singing music of Barber, Brahms, Vaughan Williams, Stanford, Wood, Sondheim and Lauridsen.

Of special interest is Serenade to Music by Ralph Vaughan Williams. With a text by William Shakespeare, this lush musical setting features many soloists as well as the full choir. This romantic gem is accompanied by piano and solo violin.

Themes of night, evening, starlight, and shadow weave throughout the hour-long program. While tickets are not required, there is a suggested \$10 donation at the door. Please invite a friend for this special concert of romantic music, just in time for Valentine's Day!






