Spotlight on Grace: Music for March

Please join us on Sunday, March 18 at 5 PM for Choral Evensong. The Grace Church Choir will sing works of Lloyd, Sheppard, Titcomb and Haydn. Of particular interest is the motet "Insanæ et vanæ curæ" by Franz Joseph Haydn. The beginnings of Haydn's motet *Insanæ et vanæ curæ* (Insane and stupid worries flood our mind) began in 1775 with the composition of his first oratorio *Il ritorno di Tobia* (The Return of Tobias). The work written to an Italian libretto was first performed in 1775 in Vienna and was a resounding success. But by 1781 the public's musical taste had changed so much that another planned performance in Vienna in 1781 failed to materialize due to lack of interest. Later

Haydn took one of the choral numbers from the oratorio and rewrote it to a Latin text, resulting in the motet featured at Evensong. The work is full of contrast - dramatic, fiery sections alternating with sublimely peaceful passages. Oboist Cheryl Bishkoff of the RI Phil will join organist Rodney Ayers to accompany Haydn's great work. Ms. Bishkoff will join Vince Edwards at the piano for the prelude music, featuring two movements of Bach's Sonata in G Minor for Oboe.

Following Evensong, you will be invited to tour the newly refurbished Vestry and Chafee Room. Following Evensong, a reception will be held in The Pavilion.

The Susquehanna University Choir, under the direction of Christopher Hoster, will be on tour March 10-18, 2018. We are delighted to include Grace Church among their scheduled performance locations, with a concert next Wednesday, March 14, from 7:00pm to roughly 8:30pm. The concert is free and open to the public.

The 42-member University Choir tours each spring and presents a varied program of classical and contemporary music. The University Chamber Singers, a versatile group of 16 musicians, will perform a segment of the concert, as well.



presently in The Pavilion at Grace.


Wheelchair Access and Accessible Parking: Please find convenient accessible in the Grace
Church parking lot with access from Snow Street. The new wheelchair ramp connects directly
from the lot, and you will enter through the new reception entrance of The Pavilion and into
the church at ground level.

Parking for Worship: Free parking for Sunday worship is provided:

- 1.) in the lot diagonally across Westminster Street, on the NW corner of Westminster and Snow;
- 2.) On the **top level only** of the PPAC parking garage, for which the entrance is on Weybosset Street. A stairway from the top level leads right to Chapel Street across from the church; and
- 3.) In the Grace Church parking lot accessed via Snow Street. We ask your kind cooperation in reserving this lot, to the extent possible, for seniors and those with limited mobility.
