A gorgeous landscape painting by plein-air artist and Grace Church parishioner Nancy <u>Friese</u> now adorns The Pavilion at Grace. The large painting -- titled *Rim of Sunlight and Trees* -- is on loan to Grace Church. We would like to express our gratitude to Nancy Friese and to <u>contemporary art</u> <u>dealer</u> and fellow Grace parishioner

Cade Tompkins for making this possible. As you will see if you haven't already, the painting is just a perfect fit for the space, and their hope is to eventually have three additional works installed as a series depicting landscapes in each season. Working consistently as a plein-air artist for the past thirty years, Nancy Friese's work captures the natural spontaneity and intertwining of clusters of trees and foliage beneath lively skies. Friese's work departs from traditional plein-air painting with heightened color and animated brush strokes. Friese's work is held in numerous public and private collections including the Boston Public Library, the New York Public Library, North Dakota Museum of Art, the RISD Museum, and the Yale University Art Gallery.

#### Weekly Worship Schedule:



Parking for Worship: Free parking for Sunday worship is provided:

1.) in the lot diagonally across Westminster Street, on the NW corner of Westminster and Snow;

2.) On the **top level only** of the PPAC parking garage, for which the entrance is on Weybosset Street. A stairway from the top level leads right to Chapel Street across from the church; and

3.) In the Grace Church parking lot accessed via Snow Street. We ask your kind cooperation in reserving this lot, to the extent possible, for seniors and those with limited mobility.
