Spotlight on Grace: An Elegant Pairing of Old and New


The final result won't appear in black and white as the image at right depicts, but this elegant design will soon grace the interior of The Pavilion at Grace as a 3-foot-diameter window installation well above the gas-lit fireplace on the South wall of the new gathering space.

You may not recognize the image, particularly in this adapted form, but chances are good that most Grace Church parishioners will have passed their glance across the inspiration for this motif many times before. As a hint: it's a work of [Ralph Adams Cram](#). The answer is revealed in an image further below.



Once the inspiration for the window was selected, artist and RISD professor Andrew Raftery -- [whose art studio is located right here in Grace Church](#) -- graciously offered to adapt, sketch and further render the motif that Centerbrook Architects then converted into a digital image. Grace Church thanks Andrew for helping to bring this vision to life.

The two fields of the image shown above in black and white will be contrasted on the window as differing degrees of clarity and opaqueness, and the result will be an elegant means of reflecting and celebrating the old amid the new. We will install the window amid the curved wall that will go in front of



the light source that you see in this image at right. The opening of translucent material called *kalwall* that you see in this picture at right will actually not be seen from the interior, but its light will filter pleasantly through the window and out the curved fins of the South wall. Adding further continuity and symmetry, we will incorporate the same image into the center stone of the labyrinth in the garden.


