Each Memorial Day we honor, remember, and give thanks for all those who paid the ultimate sacrifice in service to their country. If you have not already taken special notice of the two historical war memorial plaques inside Grace Church, this is a terrific occasion on which to do so. And if you count relatives among those named upon either plaque, we would very much like to hear from you.



At the back of the church, near our indoor coffee hour area, you'll find a plaque dedicated *In grateful memory of those from Grace Church who gave their lives for their country in World War II:*

Then follows a long list of Grace Church parishioners who served in World War II.

At the front of the church, just to the left of the Eagle as you're facing the altar, please take note of the plaque from World War I. This *Roll of Honor* is inscribed: *To those who gave their services to our country in The World War, Grace Church has placed this tablet as a grateful tribute, that remembrance of them may abide.*

Let us remember and give thanks for all those in every generation who have given their lives in service, and let us honor all members of the armed forces past and present, and the families who support them.
