The Royal School of Church Music Summer Course will take place in Newport from August 1 to 7. Over 150 choristers will gather to study, rehearse, play and perform. Vince Edwards, our Director of Music, will be on the faculty overseeing the services of Morning Prayer and Compline.

On Friday, August 5, the course's "Providence Day" culminates with Evensong here at Grace Church at 5 PM. This promises to be a magnificent service with a choir of 150! 


## Sunday School Summer Session:

## Outreach Ministry - Back to School Supply Drive


YOU can help send a vulnerable child to school ready to learn!


