

Spotlight on Grace: Cue the Music



We have scheduled our next offering of Candlesong: Reflective music for the city and the soul for Saturday, September 24, at 7:00pm. Doors open at 6:30pm. Please note that a full lighting of Waterfire is scheduled for that evening, which makes the perfect complement to Candlesong for a memorable downtown Providence experience.

We have two upcoming Services of Choral Evensong to get excited about. The first is coming up fast on Sunday, October 2 at 5:00pm, and will feature wonderful music of Tudor England. Then on All Saints' Sunday, November 6, please join us at Grace Church for a Choral Evensong with combined choirs from Grace and from St. Luke's in East Greenwich, featuring Cathedral Greats - Music of Wood, Howells and Parry.

Grace continues to expand its musical offerings for children and young people! The **Grace Church Choristers** -- a vocal program for boys and girls in grades 3-12 -- sang alongside the adult choir last Sunday, September 11, and will sing for Sunday Eucharist approximately twice per month.

Beginning Thursday, September 22 at 4:00pm, a Music Class / Training Choir for children in Kindergarten through 2nd grade will be offered at the church. There is no fee for this program, and membership at Grace Church (or any church for that matter!) is not required. The 45 minute classes will be led by Grace's Director of Music Vince Edwards. The children will learn the basics of vocal production, sight-reading skills, and music history; and will use games and movement to ensure a fun experience! This music class / training choir will serve as a training program for the Grace Church Choristers, but p articipation does not obligate anyone to continue in the Chorister Program. In case you haven't heard the exciting news: we are forming a new professional chamber choir -- made up of talented singers from all over Rhode Island -- which will be our ensemble-in-residence here at Grace Church. The group will be called **Collegium Ancora**, and will perform a diverse repertoire with an emphasis on sacred a cappella music. Please don't miss the group's premier performance Sunday, November 20 at 5:00pm: *Blessing Living and Loving*, featuring music of Handel, Byrd, Britten, Copland and more!

Please give a warm Grace Church welcome to Laura Gullett, our new **Organ Scholar**. Laura is a recent graduate of Harvard University, and is currently an analyst at healthcare consulting firm Health Advances. Laura attended St. Paul's School in Concord, NH, where she served as the Organ Scholar in Chapel. While at Harvard, Laura studied organ with Christian Lane, who was interim Director of Music at Grace. Laura will be with us approximately twice per month to accompany the choir, allowing our Music Director to be in front of the choir. This will be particularly important when our Choristers sing.

Finally, please note that music program donation envelopes have been placed on the table at the back of

the church right next to the new program schedules. We are hopeful that you will consider making a contribution in support of the music program at Grace, in addition to your regular stewardship pledge which is so important to the church. 
