## Spotlight on Grace: A Glorious Round of Evening Services

While most of us attend the Sunday morning Eucharist as our weekly worship experience, The Episcopal Church provides for other services as well, such as Morning Prayer, Noonday Prayer, Evening Prayer, and Compline. The latter two are often sung, providing a rich musical experience as the day draws to a close; whether marking the end to daylight (Evening Prayer) or the time for rest (Compline).



This Sunday, September 23, you can experience *both* of these sublime services at Grace Church.

At 4 PM, our Grace Church Choristers will sing Choral Evensong, featuring music of Davison, Jennings, Ridout, and Edwards. As part of the service, the boys and girls will receive their medals and ribbons in a ceremony modeled on Westminster Abbey's service of the same. The Investiture of Choristers is quite moving, and marks the progress each of these youngsters has made.

At 8 PM, the Grace Church Men's Schola will sing Compline, from the Latin completorium, or the completion of the day. This service is half an hour of soaring chant, glowing candlelight, and fragrant incense. The doors open at 7:30 for meditation.

Evensong and Compline will be sung on a monthly basis at Grace for this Fall 2018 through Spring 2019 season, so please take a Music at Grace brochure and plan to be with us for these evening treats as often as possible.

**Parking for Worship:** Free parking for Sunday worship is provided:

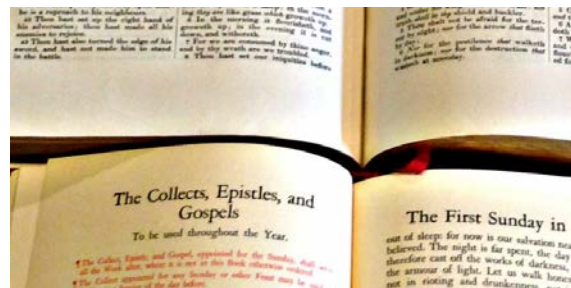
- 1.) in the lot diagonally across Westminster Street, on the NW corner of Westminster and Snow;
- 2.) On the **top level only** of the PPAC parking garage, for which the entrance is on Weybosset Street. A stairway from the top level leads right to Chapel Street across from the church; and
- 3.) In the Grace Church parking lot accessed via Snow Street. We ask your kind cooperation in reserving this lot, to the extent possible, for seniors and those with limited mobility.
