

#### Rector's Letter



From the Rector:

Twenty-three years ago, at the very end of the Soviet era, I found myself in Moscow for a few months. That December, as Christmas approached, I happened to walk past what was then one of the very few bars in the city: an Irish pub, nestled next to a Finnish supermarket. I was planning on returning home in time for Christmas, but it occurred to me that there were likely going to be expats in that pub on Christmas Day, to share the holiday with people who might be complete strangers, but at least spoke their language. Many years later, I found myself spending six Christmases in a row in a foreign country, as a priest on the staff of the American Cathedral in Paris. And on those Christmases, although I was with my family, many people who came to worship with us were alone, far from home, wanting to celebrate the birth of Christ and be with, in a sense, people who knew them, who spoke their language.

This being known, it seems to me, is at the very heart of what Christmas is about: that we are known because God himself has come down to earth at the birth of Jesus. At that first Christmas, God showed that he knows us as well as we know ourselves, because, as John's Gospel says, "The word became flesh and lived among us." (John 1:14)

For some of us, home is a place to which we are happy to

return. For others, it's a complicated or even hard place. There's an old magazine ad that used to say, "Home is where you find it," but, in fact, home is where God finds you. That may be in a house with your blood relations on Christmas Eve, or it may be with friends, or in your local church, in a church in a foreign land, or even in an Irish pub in Moscow surrounded by people you've never met.

Wherever you are, whoever you're with, may you find home, where God knows and loves you. That could be just about any place.
