Grace to Go Generates 400 Meals

The new *Grace to Go* meal-kit ministry at Grace Church, spearheaded by Pastoral Associate Hartwell Hylton and supported by a throng of energetic volunteers, officially launched last Saturday, March 23, with its inaugural meal-kit assembly operation in The Pavilion at Grace. We would like to thank all who participated, including all

those taking





part in the A New Heart series with Maria DeCarvalho, since after-cost proceeds from that series will directly benefit Grace to Go.

With just this first effort, Grace to Go assembled 200 shelf-stable meal kits -- representing 400 meals (since each kit is a meal for two) -- which have been transferred to <u>Better Lives RI (formerly PICA)</u> for distribution directly to families in need through their community food pantry. Over time, the ministry may expand to include additional distribution partners for its meal kits.

Both through the regular and collective efforts of our parishioners in donating non-perishable food items on Sunday mornings for the Better Lives RI food pantry, and now through this new ministry and its easy-to-prepare kits for making a savory Jambalaya, the Grace Church community is

providing meaningful direct support to help ensure the shelves of the Better Lives RI pantry are stocked to meet the substantial need for food assistance here in our downtown community.

1.) in the lot diagonally across Westminster Street, on the NW corner of Westminster and Snow;

2.) On the **top level only** of the PPAC parking garage, for which the entrance is on Weybosset Street. A stairway from the top level leads right to Chapel Street across from the church; and

3.) In the Grace Church parking lot accessed via Snow Street. We ask your kind cooperation in reserving this lot, to the extent possible, for seniors and those with limited mobility.
