
• We plan to wash all cars in the church lot as of 9:15 am, so please simply park in

- If you want a car wash and aren't in time to get into the church lot, no worries. Just bring your car over to the church lot right after services end, and we'll wash your car while you enjoy coffee hour.
- Likewise, if you don't want or need a car wash, please park in another lot. If parking in another lot is not an option for you for any reason, just tell us when you arrive you don't want a car wash, and we'll put a note on your dashboard to skip your car.

directly from the lot, and you will enter through the new reception entrance of The Pavilion and into the church at ground level.


Parking for Worship: Free parking for Sunday worship is provided:
