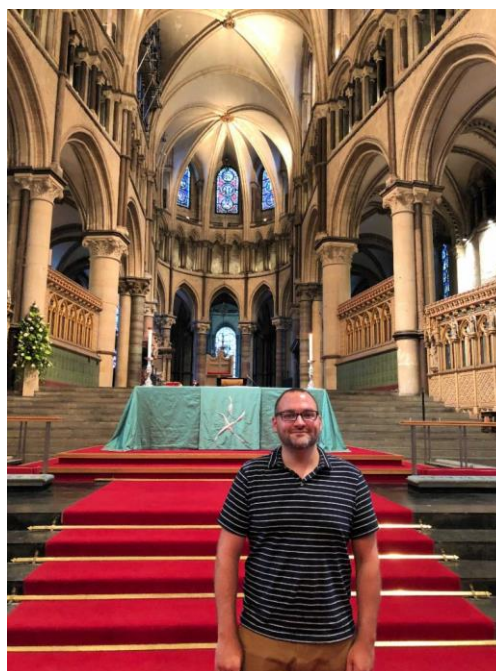

Nick Halar, while spending some time in London for work, took a trek out to Canterbury to worship at the Canterbury Cathedral on a recent Sunday. While there were no sightings of the [Archbishop of Canterbury](#), Nick enjoyed a beautiful day experiencing the town and attending Sunday worship and Evensong.

Canterbury Cathedral is the Mother Church of the worldwide Anglican Communion, and the seat of the Archbishop of Canterbury. [Archbishop Justin Welby](#) became the 105th individual to hold the title in 2013, continuing a line of succession which goes back more than 1400 years to Augustine of Canterbury, the "Apostle to the English", sent from Rome in the year 597.

All are welcome to attend. May the soul of Mama Kelley, and the souls of all the departed, rest in eternal peace.

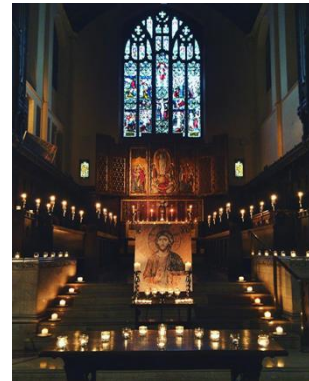

**Parking for Worship:** Free parking for Sunday worship is provided:

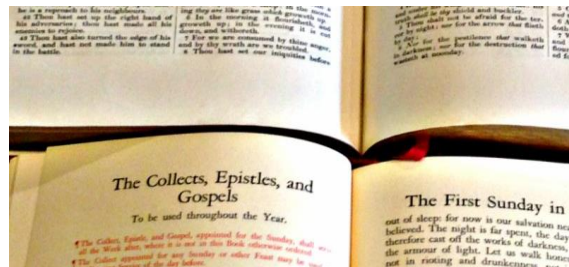
- 1.) in the lot diagonally across Westminster Street, on the NW corner of Westminster and Snow; and
