Spotlight on Grace Advent is Here.....and Christmas is Coming!

This year, as we prepare for the annual celebration of the birth of Christ, Grace Church will have some annual favorites, some new events, and the return of something we've done in the past. As always, the 10 a.m. service on the third Sunday in Advent will feature our children's Christmas pageant. That same night (at 7 p.m.), we'll have a special Advent Compline (more details below), and the day prior we'll have the return of our Christmas Carol Singalong in The Pavilion garden. Finally, on the 22nd, the choir (including the choristers) and *Collegium Ancora* will together sing Händel's Messiah. December is a full month here at Grace, which is, after all, as it should be. This service is meant to embody the beginning of our anticipation of the coming of our Savior. A reception will follow in The Pavilion.


Parking for Worship: Free parking for Sunday worship is provided:
