Handel's great oratorio Messiah has been in existence for nearly 280 years. First performed in Dublin in April 1742, the Messiah received only modest public approval. That's difficult for us to believe as this magnificent work has gone on to become one of the most beloved choral pieces of all time. Please plan to join us this Sunday, December 22 at 4:00 PM for a



performance of Part I (the "Christmas" portion) of Messiah, along with the noble "Hallelujah" chorus. The Grace Church Choir and Choristers will be joined by members of *Collegium Ancora*, and accompanied by the Providence Baroque Chamber Orchestra. The concert is under an hour, and no tickets are required - just a \$10 suggeted donation at the door. We are pleased to offer this timeless music to the downtown Providence community, and hope that many of you will make it part of your Advent and Christmas celebration this year.
