

3. Click "Create Your Online Profile".
4. Follow the prompts to complete your pledge.

Establish regular weekly or monthly offerings, or respond to special appeals... all right on your smartphone!

1. Visit the App Store or Google Play and search for "GivePlus" to download the app.
2. Enter "Grace Church in Providence" in the app, choose which fund you'd like to support (e.g. Pledge), and you're on your way.
3. Consider sourcing your contribution from a checking or savings account to maximize your contribution, or if using a card please consider selecting the option: "Help Offset the Processing Fee".

During this period of social distancing, it comforts us to recall our moments together and reflect upon the strength and vibrancy of our Grace Church community.




This photo is from our parish barbecue on June 24, 2018; our first event in the courtyard following the Fall 2017 completion of The Pavilion.

Details of the Temporary Closure at Grace

This closure impacts all parish activities at least through the end of March (and likely through May), including Sunday worship, the Open Doors ministry, the Wednesday Eucharist, the Thursday Noon concert, the Thursday Lenten Eucharist and dinner, the Stations of the Cross liturgy on Fridays, all meetings and ministry gatherings, all music lessons and choir rehearsals, and the Compline services which had been scheduled for this Sunday evening. We will continue to send a weekly ENews, so please stay tuned for further updates and some form of online worship experience that we intend to provide.


The Fifth Sunday in Lent
