
Create Your Online Profile

Establish regular weekly or monthly offerings, or respond to special appeals... all right on your smartphone!

1. Visit the App Store or Google Play and search for "GivePlus" to download the app.
2. Enter "Grace Church in Providence" in the app, choose which fund you'd like to support (e.g. Pledge), and you're on your way.
3. Consider sourcing your contribution from a checking or savings account to maximize your contribution, or if using a card please consider selecting the option: "Help Offset the Processing Fee".




Details of the Temporary Closure at Grace
