## An Overview of Holy Week Worship Services

Though Holy Week will be quite different this year, the clergy, staff, and parishioners of Grace are all working hard to continue to bring Voices of Grace our "Virtual" Worship platform to life during this most holiest of seasons. We have been busy recording and putting together "virtual" versions of the important liturgies of the church year. And every morning from Wednesday through Sunday, an email with the video(s) and Order of Service(s) for that day will be included.

**Holy Wednesday:** *"Virtual Worship" - Choral Compline for Holy Week*

**Maundy Thursday:** *Voices of Grace - "Virtual" Worship and a "Virtual" Garden Watch*

Beginning at 8:00PM on the Grace Church Facebook Page, a Livestream video will be set up with the camera on the Altar of Repose in the Chapel of the Messiah which will be decorated to represent the Garden of Gethsemane. During a 'normal' Holy Week, following the liturgies of the Washing of Feet, Holy Eucharist, and Stripping of the Altar on Maundy Thursday, a "night watch" in the chapel would take place until midnight with the doors of the church open so that those who wish to pray and keep vigil the night before Christ's crucifixion may do so. We will continue this tradition, though "virtually". You can participate by simply following this link or by visiting the Grace Church Facebook Page at any point between 8:00 and 10:00 PM on Thursday evening.


**Good Friday:** *Voices of Grace - "Virtual" Worship and "Virtual" Way of the Cross*
