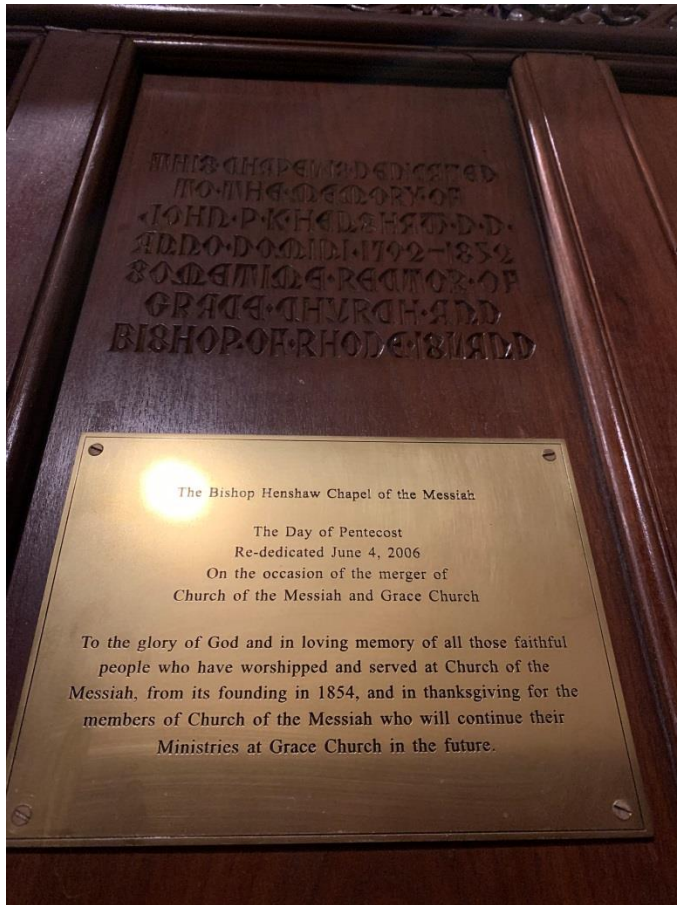


# VIEWS OF GRACE

## THE BISHOP HENSHAW CHAPEL OF THE MESSIAH



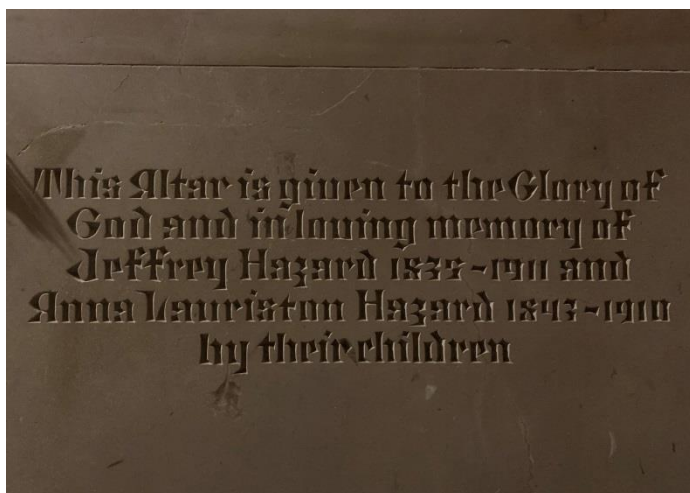
*The original chapel dedication inscription reads:*

**THIS CHAPEL IS DEDICATED  
TO THE MEMORY OF  
JOHN P. K. HENSHAW, D.D.  
ANNO DOMINI 1792-1852,  
SOMETIME RECTOR OF  
GRACE CHURCH AND  
BISHOP OF RHODE ISLAND**

by their children**
