Upcoming 'Virtual' Ash Wednesday Holy Eucharist of the Pre-Sanctified & Self-Imposition of Ashes February 17, 2021 at 6:00 PM

Much like on the Feast days of The Epiphany and The Presentation (Candlemas), we will gather as a church to observe the beginning of the season of Lent next week, with a 'virtual' eucharist on Zoom. Pre-consecrated hosts, printed Orders of Service, and small containers of ashes will be available for pick-up from the church (see pick-up times below). In addition to 'virtual' communion, we'll also have the Blessing and Imposition of Ashes, during which people will be invited to mark their own foreheads and/ or the



foreheads of their family/'pod' with the sign of the Cross. We hope to see you all via Zoom to mark this special season of penitence, meditation, prayer, and fasting, that allows us to reflect on Christ's sacrifice for us in anticipation of the resurrection!

Worship with the Canterbury Cathedral Community


