B ELOVED IN CHRIST, forty days ago we celebrated the joyful feast of the incarnation of Jesus. Today we recall the day on which he was presented in the temple, fulfilling the law of Moses. Led by the Spirit, Simeon and Anna came to the temple, recognized the child as the Christ, and proclaimed him with joy. United by the same Spirit, we now invite God to enter into our homes, where we shall recognize Christ in the breaking of bread.



#### THE BLESSING OVER THE CANDLES

*Celebrant* Let us pray.

ETERNAL GOD, who has created all things; on this day you fulfilled the petitions of the just Simeon: we humbly ask you to  $\mathbf{X}$  bless and sanctify these candles for our use. Graciously hear our prayers and be merciful to us, whom you have redeemed by your Son, who is the light of the world, and who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God for ever and ever. Amen.

During the singing of the Nunc Dimittis, all are invited to light their candles.

The Nunc Dimittis is sung by the prophet Simeon upon seeing the child Jesus presented in the temple.

#### THE LESSONS

THE OLD TESTAMENT LESSON

HUS SAYS THE LORD, See, I am sending my messenger to prepare the way before me, and the LORD whom you seek will suddenly come to his temple. THE HOLY GOSPEL

Luke 2:22-40

## *Deacon* The Holy Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ, according to Luke.*People* Glory be to you, Lord Christ.

HEN THE TIME CAME FOR THEIR PURIFICATION according to the law of Moses, the parents of Jesus brought him up to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord (as it is written in the law of the Lord, "Every firstborn male shall be designated as holy to the Lord"), and they offered a sacrifice according to what is stated in the law of the Lord, "a pair of turtledoves or two young pigeons." Now there was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Simeon; this man was righteous and devout, looking forward to the consolation of Israel, and the Holy Spirit rested on him. It had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not see death before he had seen the Lord's Messiah. Guided by the Spirit, Simeon came into the temple; and when the parents brought in the child Jesus, to do for him what was customary under the law, Simeon took him in his arms and praised God, saying, "Master, now you are dismissing your servant in peace,

according to your word; for my eyes have seen your salvation, which you have prepared in the presence of all peoples, a light for revelation to the Gentiles and for glory to your people Israel." And the child's father and mother were amazed at what was being said about him. Then Simeon blessed them and said to his mother Mary, "This child is destined for the falling and the rising of many in Israel, and to be a sign that will be opposed so that the inner thoughts of many will be revealed and a sword will pierce your own soul too." There was also a prophet, Anna the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Asher. She was of a great age, having lived with her husband seven years after her marriage, then as a widow to the age of eightyfour. She never left the temple but worshiped there with fasting and prayer night and day. At that moment she came, and began to praise God and to speak about the child to all who were looking for the redemption of Jerusalem. When they had



finished everything required by the law of the Lord, they returned to Galilee, to their own town of Nazareth. The child grew and became strong, filled with wisdom; and the favor of God was upon him.
