



Information for Making Vaccination Appointments

In the interest of helping our parishioners gain access to the COVID-19 vaccine as quickly as availability and eligibility will allow, we offer the following information and links.

Eligibility: Presently anyone age 65 or older is eligible to receive the vaccine, plus healthcare workers, first responders, and those in congregate settings. Up-to-date [eligibility information can be found here](#).



Vaccination Appointments:

Rhode Island has 2 state-run, large-scale vaccination sites (in Providence and Cranston), and [appointments can be made here](#). For best availability, new appointment slots are added each Tuesday at 9am and Friday at 5pm. If you are not comfortable navigating the appointment process online, there is an automated phone line at 844-930-1779.

[CVS](#) and [Walgreens](#) offer by-appointment vaccinations as supplies allow.

Some cities and towns in RI are offering municipal vaccination clinics. [Contact your own municipality directly](#) for information. And finally, [Lifespan](#) is providing some vaccination appointments through its hospital network.

Those who are homebound and unable to travel to a vaccination site, [can indicate that need here](#). {This is not to make an appointment, but only to indicate the need.}
