Spotlight: Upcoming Collegium Ancora Concert

This weekend marks the return of Collegium Ancora! Sunday's 4:00 PM concert will feature Handel's brilliant setting of Dixit Dominus for chorus, soloists, and chamber orchestra. One of Handel's most difficult choral works, Dixit Dominus makes extraordinary demands of the singers, but rewards accordingly. The text is Psalm 110, plus the Gloria Patri, and Handel uses fantastic musical themes and motives to paint the text of this very colorful psalm text. The 22 singers will be joined by members of the Providence Baroque Chamber Orchestra. The second half of the program features arias from Handel's many and varied operas and oratorios, such as Giulio Cesare, Rinaldo, and Jephtha.
