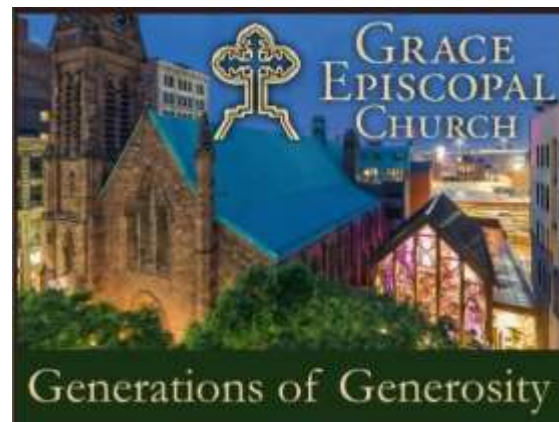
Christmas Flowers & Music Dedications

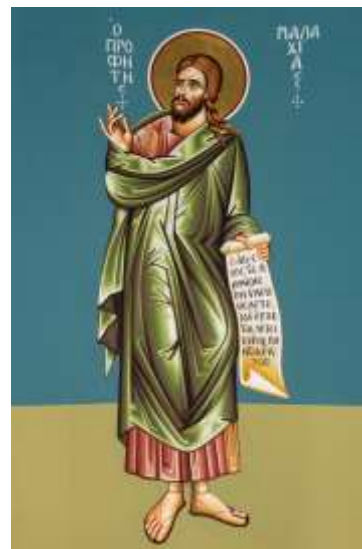
