# Upcoming Annual Parish Meeting

The 193rd annual meeting of the parish will take place in the church immediately following 10:00 a.m. service on Sunday, February



27th to hear reports from parish leaders and elect vestry members. The Vestry Nominating Committee (Diane Stamp, Sue Hall, Joseph Berryhill, Bill Galligan, Melody Ennis) will present the following slate for the Vestry: for a second, three-year term - Lori Brown, Carissa Mills, and Joel Goloskie, and for a first, full, three-year term - Nicholas Halar. The Committee is also presenting Adrienne Southgate as our delegate to Diocesan Convention, and Melody Ennis as the Alternate Delegate.

## Organ Project Update

We are SO EXCITED to announce that we have had TWO generous gifts to the Organ Project! First, we have a \$25,000 CHALLENGE GRANT from a family in the parish. They have asked to remain anonymous, but in their words "hope that their gift

A second anonymous gift of \$50,000 has been pledged from a friend of Music at Grace.
