

We have an exciting update on our Organ Project at Grace fundraising efforts! As of March 27, we met the \$25,000 matching gift challenge from the Chamberlain family! This brings our current Organ Project fund amount to over \$120,000! We still have a long way to go to \$2 Million, and we still are hoping to find a donor who will make a large, single donation to help bring this project to fruition. We are so grateful to those of you have made gifts and/or pledges. We have another matching gift challenge waiting “in the wings” - stay tuned just after Easter for updates. Thursdays at Noon Concerts


The next concert will be on April 28,
