

#### Pentecost at Grace Church

This Sunday, Grace Church – along with churches throughout the world – celebrates the Feast of Pentecost, the day on which the Holy Spirit descended upon the apostles. As part of that great event, we will be following two Pentecost traditions. The first is baptism – at the 10 a.m. service on Sunday we'll be baptizing several children into the Christian faith. Secondly, all are invited to wear red to church on Sunday. The color recalls the flames of fire that rested over the heads of the apostles when the Holy Spirit descended on the 50 day after the Resurrection. The feast day concludes the Easter season, so for a final time this year, Happy Easter!
