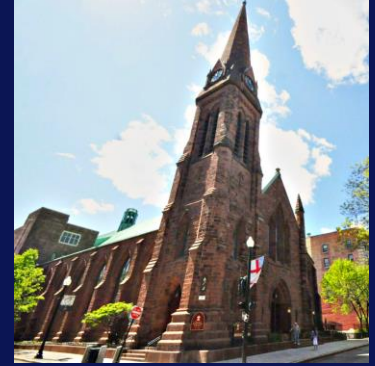

Special Musical Guest this Sunday

This coming Sunday we will welcome, violinist Alexander Hardan who will be playing at the 10:00 AM Eucharist. Alex is a Ph.D. student in Musicology & Ethnomusicology at Brown University, where he works on Soviet musical pedagogy and performance as an instrument of “Sovietization” in Cuba during the Cold War. Specifically, Hardan focuses on discourses of Soviet “national sounds” and choreographies of virtuosity produced in Soviet Cuba, and the subsequent effects of this musical Sovietization on the Cuban state’s ideal revolutionary subject. Outside of the Cold War, he is also interested in performance studies and queer theory, namely the ways in which normative ideas of gender have conditioned ideas of virtuosic performance. Hardan holds a B.Mus. in Violin Performance and M.Mus. degrees in both Violin Performance and Musicology from the Peabody Conservatory of the Johns Hopkins University, as well as an M.A. in Ethnomusicology from Brown University.

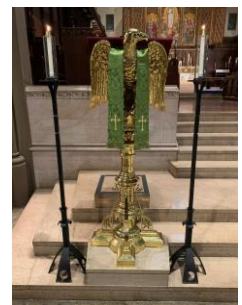
