A special service of Choral Evensong featuring music by 16th century English composer William Byrd, in observance of 400 years since his death.

Choral Compline on the Feast of Saint Joseph of Nazareth

March 19th at 8:00 PM (Doors open at 7:30 PM)

Half an hour of Gregorian chant and Renaissance polyphony, sung by the Grace Church Schola in a darkened church lighted by candles and filled with fragrant incense.

Wednesdays at 12 Noon

Spoken Holy Eucharist with a brief homily in The Chapel of the Messiah.

Thursday Lenten Eucharists – 6:00 PM

A short Eucharist service with music, prayers, and a brief sermon preached by retired clergy who have made Grace Church their spiritual home.

The service takes place in the Chancel near the High Altar amongst candlelight and incense for a more intimate worship experience.

A light potluck supper in The Pavilion follows the service.
