# Spotlight: U.K. Choir Pilgrimage

Exciting news!!! The Grace Church Choristers and members of the Grace Church Choir will be "crossing the pond" in August to sing services at two English cathedrals! From August 7 to 11, the choir will be in residence at Salisbury Cathedral, one of the greatest buildings in England. While there, the choir will sing daily Evensong services in the cathedral, taking the place of the cathedral's own choir who will be on holiday. Our choristers will



reside in Salisbury Cathedral School on the grounds of the cathedral, essentially living the life of an British chorister for a few days. From Salisbury, the choir will travel to London and will sing the morning and evening services at Southwark Cathedral, located on the south side of the Thames, near London Bridge and the Globe Theatre. The East end of Southwark cathedral contains the oldest portion of ecclesiastical architecture in London. On Monday, the choir will enjoy a sightseeing day in London before heading back to Providence.

If you want a sneak preview of what we will be doing in England, then come to Evensong this Sunday at 4 PM at Grace! The choir will sing music of Rheinberger, Spicer, Dyson and Moore. A reception will follow!
