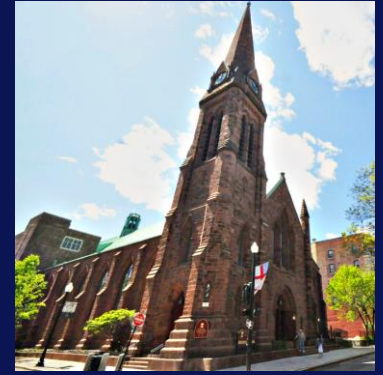

## Spotlight: Collegium Ancora Concert this Sunday

What a perfect weekend to celebrate all things British! On the heels of the Coronation of King Charles III, Collegium Ancora will present a concert of music by Benjamin Britten, perhaps the greatest 20th century British composer. We will be singing some well-known works, such as the cantata Rejoice in the Lamb, with a text by the brilliant, but tortured Christopher Smart. Scored for organ and choir, this is one of Britten's most beloved and enduring works. The program will also include secular music, particularly the Flower Songs. Scored for a cappella SATB choir, these lovely, quirky, and even rambunctious settings are perfect for spring! The 4:00 PM concert will last under an hour and is followed by a reception. Tickets are \$20 and available at the door. Give yourself a British treat and join us!
