ABOUT THE ENSEMBLE

MISSION

Dedicated to enriching the Ocean State through the choral arts, by singing music from times ancient to modern, sacred to secular, all in celebration of the human voice.

Founded in 2016, Collegium Ancora is a professional chamber choir made up of talented singers from all over Rhode Island. The group serves as ensemble-in-residence at Grace Episcopal Church in Providence, rehearsing and performing in the splendid 170-year old building. Vince Edwards, our founding Artistic Director, wanted to build a group that was really indigenous to Rhode Island, celebrating the talent and musical ability that is so present in Providence and the greater Rhode Island community. The choir has approximately 40 members on the roster and between 18 and 24 singers will perform at any given concert. The name was chosen for a several reasons collegium, which means "a group whose members pursue shared goals"; and ancora which is Latin for hope and anchor, both present on the Rhode Island state seal.

Continuing the celebration of English Renaissance composer William Byrd's 400th Anniversary Year, Collegium Ancora will sing some of his most wondrous sacred works and some of his most playful secular music, particularly where Byrd and "bird" overlap! The program will also feature music by some of his contemporaries and successors, both from his native England, and the European continent to showcase the wide-spread influence of his musical style of composition.

A concert featuring two works that exemplify the pinnacle of both a cappella and accompanied choral settings of the Mass Ordinary: Ralph Vaughan Williams' **Mass in G Minor for Soloists & Double Choir** and Zoltán Kodály's **Missa Brevis for Choir & Organ.** Collegium will be joined by prize-winning, Latvian-American organist, Dāvids Heinze for the Kodály.

REPERTOIRE

While *Collegium Ancora* focuses on sacred *a cappella* (unaccompanied) music, the group sings quite a diverse repertoire, which is reflected in the schedule of performances each season.



Recent concerts have included G.F. Händel's oratorio *Israel in Egypt*, Henry Purcell's *Te Deum and Jubilate*, Antonio Vivaldi's *Gloria*, *Choral Dances* from Benjamin Britten's *Gloriana*, *O schöne Nacht* by Johannes Brahms, and David Conte's *Elegy for Matthew Shepherd*.

SPARK COMPOSITION COMPETITION

In addition to their own programming, *Collegium Ancora* is pleased to serve as the premiering ensemble for winners of the SPARK Composition Competition. The selected works are presented at one of the scheduled performances during each season. In 2019, the first winner of the competition was *To the Rainbow* by Dr. Tamsin Jones of Carlisle, England.
