Upcoming Choral Compline

Join us this coming Sunday, September 17 at 8:00 PM for the first service of Choral Compline of the choral season. The church will be filled with hundreds of candles and sweet-smelling incense will waft through the air as the Grace Church Schola sings unaccompanied Gregorian chant and Renaissance polyphony. The service is short, only 30-minutes and is an excellent way to start/end your week! Doors open at 7:30 PM for silent prayer and meditation before the service. Come worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness!





Organ Project Update

We have been seeking funding for the restoration and renovation of the Grace Church pipe organ since October 2021 when the Vestry authorized the Organ Project at Grace. While we have raised nearly \$200,000 in gifts and pledges, we are a long way from our goal of the nearly \$2,000,000 needed for the front organ project. In the meantime, the pipes and windchests have become essentially unusable, having had no



serious maintenance since their installation in 1959. The digital voices and new console installed in 2010 were intended to function with a restored pipe organ, which has not happened yet. In order to find a more successful and musical solution in the interim period, the Vestry authorized the installation of a Hauptwerk organ. This is digital software that allows us to choose from various well-known instruments from around the world that have been digitally "sampled". We will be using the Salisbury Cathedral organ here at Grace, while we continue to seek funding for our pipe organ project. The current console has been relocated to the Narthex and will be listed for sale very soon. In the meantime, we will have a more practical and musical solution in the form of our Hauptwerk organ. NB: A generous parishioner donated the funds for this project. Also, the Hauptwerk organ will be moved to Cronhimer Hall as a practice instrument and for use during choir rehearsals once the pipe organ project is completed.
