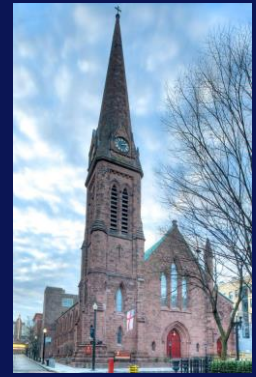

**8:00 PM**

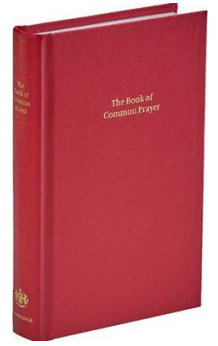
*Doors open at 7:30 PM*
