



## Farewell, Hartwell Hylton!

This coming Sunday will be the Rev. Hartwell Hylton's last Sunday at Grace as our associate rector. Hartwell came to Grace in 2018 as part of his preparation for the priesthood. Prior to his arrival at Grace, Hartwell had a distinguished career as a lawyer in New York City (as well as London and Hong Kong).

After retiring from his law firm, Hartwell received his Master of Divinity degree from Yale Divinity School and a certificate in Anglican Studies from Berkeley Divinity School at Yale. After graduation, our bishop wisely invited Hartwell to enter the ordination process in our diocese



and suggested he serve at Grace as part of the process. Just as wisely, Bishop Knisely allowed Fr. Hylton to join the staff at Grace once he became a priest. Now, feeling the time has come for him to relocate to a parish closer to his home in Darien, CT (Grace does give him a 4-hour, round-trip commute each week!), Hartwell has reached the time of leave-taking from Grace.

I have been blessed to serve alongside Hartwell in ordained ministry at our beloved church for the past 4 years, and his presence in our community, and in the pulpit, has been a blessing to all of us. I hope to see many of you in church on Sunday as we bid farewell to Hartwell and wish him well in his next ministry a bit closer to home.

## Update on the Organ Restoration

Earlier this week, Father Jonathan Huyck and Director of Music Vince Edwards signed the contract with Casavant Freres for the restoration, refurbishment, and enhancement of the Grace Church organ! The team at Casavant have been wonderful to work with, and the resulting specification is the result of a real collaboration. The final result is an organ only 3 ranks and a couple hundred pipes bigger than the 1959 project, but

which does so much to expand the color palette and broaden the 16' and 8' foot line of the organ.

The organ will be removed this fall and will (hopefully) be back in place for Christmas 2026. We are so excited and look forward to every aspect of this project!
